

**PENSACOLA GREYHOUND TRACK  
MINI BAD BEAT TEXAS HOLD'EM PROMOTION**

**PROMOTION RULES**

1. Participation constitutes entrant's full and unconditional agreement to and acceptance of these Promotion Rules
2. Beginning January 1, 2012, the Pensacola Greyhound Track Poker Room (PGT) will offer the Mini Bad Beat Promotion for Texas Hold'em on the following days and times:
  - a. 12:00 midnight – 4:00 AM Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday
  - b. 12:00 midnight – 10:00 AM Friday and Saturday
3. At showdown, a qualifying hand must beat another qualifying hand
  - a. A qualifying hand must be Aces Full or better
  - b. Both hole cards must play to qualify
  - c. If Aces Full is used, there must be at least one ace in the player's hand to qualify
  - d. A qualifying hand must be the player's highest ranking hand
4. The Jackpot prize of \$2000 will be awarded as follows:
  - a. \$1000 will go to the player with the best qualifying non-winning hand
  - b. \$500 will go to the player with the best qualifying winning hand
  - c. \$500 will be divided among the remaining players at the table who were dealt cards in the qualifying mini bad beat hand
  - d. Only one jackpot will be awarded each hand—only the best two qualifying hands will be considered when awarding a jackpot
5. Only one prize per player will be awarded each hand
6. Participants must be 18 years of age or older and possess a valid ID
